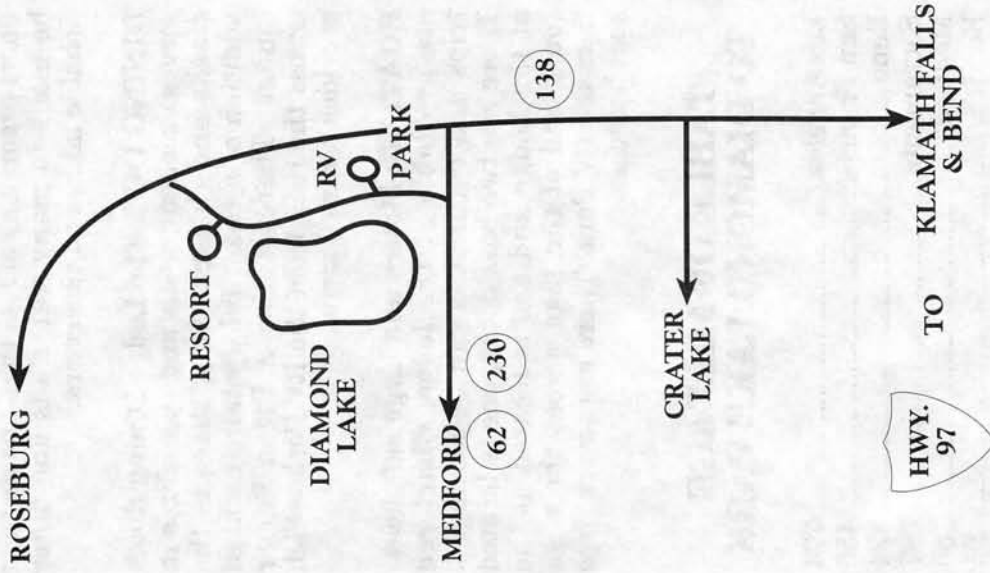

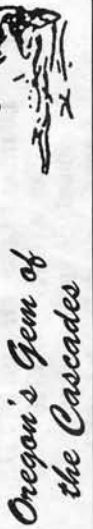

**DIAMOND LAKE RV PARK** is privately owned and operated on leased government land in the Umpqua National Forest. The park provides 120 RV spaces, water, electricity, sewer, garbage service, showers and laundry facilities. The lake, boating facilities, pizza parlor and store are all within easy walking distance from the park. The season begins in early May and closes October 1st.

**LOCATION:** Diamond Lake RV Park is located on the summit of the Cascade Mountains 85 miles from Medford, Oregon, and about the same distance from Klamath Falls or Roseburg, Oregon, and 13 miles from Crater Lake. The elevation at Diamond Lake is 5,200 feet.

**ACTIVITIES:** The lake is nestled between snowcapped Mt. Thielsen and Mt. Bailey. Such a setting provides the perfect spot for hiking, berry-picking, fishing, swimming, horseback riding, scenic drives and picnicking.

**CLIMATE:** The summer climate is ideal. The nights are cool and sometimes frosty. The days are warm and balmy. It seldom rains during the summer months.

**FISHING:** Diamond Lake is renowned as the best trout lake in Oregon. It is rightly called *The Gem of the Cascades*. Large Rainbow trout are easily taken on bait, troll and fly. Excellent fishing is available at the Rogue and Umpqua Rivers within easy driving distance from the park.

**SWIMMING:** Sandy beaches are to be found at both ends of the lake and are very popular with the whole family during July and August. Water skiing is not permitted at Diamond Lake.

**BICYCLING:** A paved 11 mile, off road path offers a scenic tour of the Diamond Lake area.

**RIDING:** Bridle paths surround the lake. Gentle horses will take you over well-marked trails to nearby lakes and scenic attractions.

**HIKING:** The famous *Pacific Crest Trail* is at you back door and you will find many miles of forest trails in the area. Short excursions of less than one day can be made to many waterfalls and other fishable lakes and reservoirs.

**DINING OUT:** The Lodge Dining Room serves excellent meals and specializes in steaks and chicken. Also, there is the addition of a beautiful upstairs cocktail lounge. There is also a Pizza Parlor across the road from the RV Park which provides a varied menu.

**BOATING:** Motors and large safe boats are available at the lodge. Chartered trips and excursions can be arranged. There are two boat docks, one is located at the Lodge and one is located at the south end of the lake across the road from the RV Park. There are several free boat launches.
